On October 25, 2021, Psi Alpha Alpha, in Fairfax, Virginia students from the MANUP Mentoring Program, heard from Mr. Tee Carty, a financial coach volunteer with the Financial Empowerment Center at South County in Alexandria. Coach Carty spoke to the 80+ students on the importance of personal finance and planning at a young age. The interactive orientation included participation from students on topics of debt, budgeting, saving for short term, mid-term, and long-term financial goals, and the understanding of key aspects to ensuring financial freedom in preparing for retirement at a young age.
