

## TANF ELIGIBILITY GUIDE

**Applies to clients from October 15, 2021 – June 30, 2022**

In order to qualify for Britepaths TANF funds, clients must have all 3 of the following:

**INCOME:** Clients must have a monthly income of 200% of federal poverty level or below. 200% is in chart below:

# of people in household	Monthly income	Annual Income
2	\$2,178	\$26,130
3	\$2,745	\$32,940
4	\$3,313	\$39,750
5	\$3,880	\$46,560
6	\$4,448	\$53,370
7	\$5,015	\$60,180
8	\$5,583	\$66,990
More than 8, add \$567 for each person		

**DEPENDENT CHILDREN:** Must have at least one child

- Under the age 18, or if 18, but not yet 19, enrolled and attending a secondary school or vocational/technical school of secondary equivalency and is meeting the enrollment and attendance requirements as determined by the local school board
- Living with a parent or other relative

**CITIZEN OR ELIGIBLE IMMIGRANT:** the client applying for assistance, must be

- A citizen
  - born in US;
  - born outside of US to citizen parents {mother if unmarried});
  - naturalized citizen
- Immigrated lawfully prior to August 22, 1996
- Immigrated lawfully on or after August 22, 1996 and has lived in US for 5 years
- Been granted asylum
- Lawfully admitted refugee from Iraq, Afghanistan, Cuba, or Haiti – this gets messy, if they are willing to give you their details we can figure it out, but it all depends on which program they came in under. Check with Lynn if you have the details.
